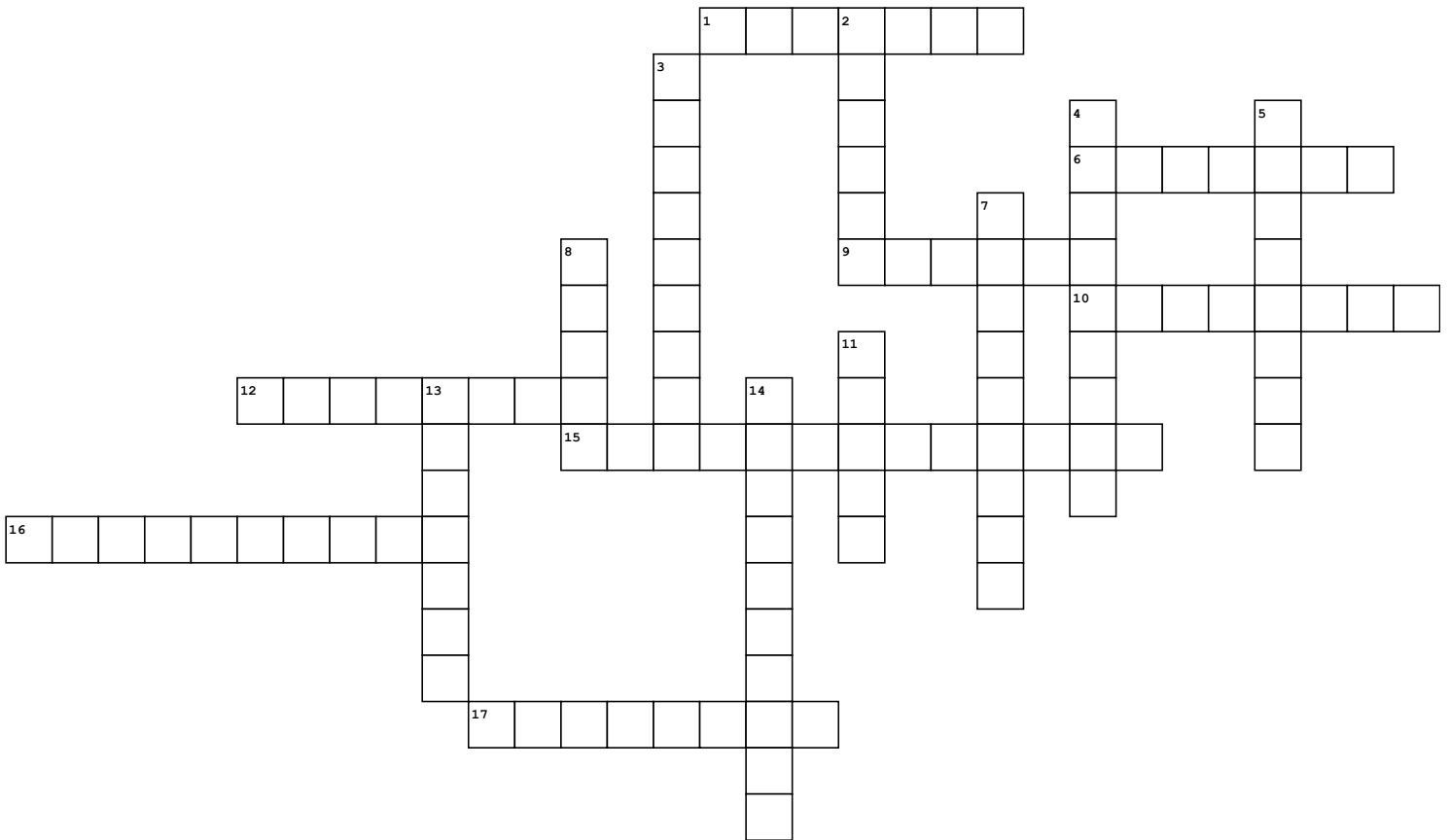


Rivers

6. - Area where a river meets the sea, characterized by brackish water.
9. - The origin or starting point of a river.
10. - Relating to the banks of a river or stream.
12. - Particles of soil and rock carried by a river.
15. - Power generated from the movement of water.
16. - Flat, fertile land adjacent to a river that is prone to flooding.
17. - Overflow of water onto normally dry land.

2. - Fast-flowing, turbulent sections of a river.
3. - Area of land where all water drains into a common point.
4. - Artificial lake created by damming a river.
5. - A large, powerful waterfall.
7. - A smaller river or stream that flows into a larger one.
8. - The endpoint or discharge of a river into a larger body of water.
11. - Landform at the mouth of a river, formed by sediment deposition.
13. - A winding curve or bend in a river.
14. - The point where two rivers meet.
